#### Southern Baptists Take Strong Actions to Stop Sexual Abuse in Our Churches

Most of you are aware that the Southern Baptist Convention has been addressing the problem of sexual abuse and assault in recent years. After an investigative report by the Houston Chronicle and San Antonio Express revealed that over a 20-year period, there were 700 cases of sexual abuse documented in Southern Baptist Churches, Southern Baptists had a zeal to aggressively address this sin in our churches. The report discovered that 380 Southern Baptist pastors, staff and volunteers had been accused of sexual assault resulting in 220 convictions. Based on that report, the Executive Committee of the Southern Baptist Convention hired an outside firm, Guidepost Solutions, to further study the problem and to report back to the Executive Committee with their findings as well as recommendations for best practices for preventing future sexual abuse. The Executive Committee did an internal study and produced their own list of names of pastors and denominational leaders who had been convicted of sexual impropriety. This list had some high profile Southern Baptist leaders who subsequently were terminated from their positions or resigned promptly. What was discovered from the Guidepost study was that churches sometimes fired a person for sexual impropriety without filing any legal charges or notifying the appropriate legal authorities. The church was often caught in a "he said, she said" situation and rather than file charges and allow the appropriate authorities to discern if abuse had happened, they simply fired the person.....
