As a pastor, evangelist and full-time cowboy, Sam Anderson has spent the last fifteen years of his life in ministry working to bring the gospel to other cowboys around the globe.

From a young age, Anderson knew he wanted to serve God through evangelism: "I've always been interested in evangelism. It's been one of my basic strengths for as long as I can remember. In college, I was even the chair of the Baptist Student Union's evangelism team. Sharing the gospel has been a priority my whole life."

Anderson's love of evangelism, coupled with his lifelong passion for all things horses and cowboys, led him to pursue full-time cowboy ministry. "I've always had horses for most of my life, but when I found out that other horse people can't go to church because of horse shows or training, I knew I had to do something about it."

Since his realization over 15 years ago, Anderson has been focused on providing a place and time for cowboys to come together and worship Christ.
