
Consider the international nature of the announcement of Christ's birth: 8 In the same region there were some shepherds staying out in the fields and keeping watch over their flock at night. 9 And an angel of the Lord suddenly stood near them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them; and they were terribly frightened. 10 And so the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid; for behold, I bring you good news of great joy which will be for all the people; 11 for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is [h]Christ the Lord. (Luke 2)

Because of what happened in Bethlehem of Judea 2000 years ago, a great movement of God in the world was set in motion that has transformed the history of the world more than any other single event.
